Clarification

A few weeks ago at mass, Father announced that the Stations of the Cross were in bad shape as well as St. Joseph and St. Mary statues. He stated "the Stations of the Cross are in poor condition and would cost a lot of money to repair. So eventually they will need to be replaced. We don't have the money for this now and they look okay hanging on the wall. So we will not be fixing or replacing the Stations of the Cross. As for the statues, there was money leftover from the painting project and we have been given permission from certain donors to use this money to restore St. Joseph/St. Mary." All current projects were funded by parishioners. None of the building fund, general fund, or any other fund was used in paying for these projects. 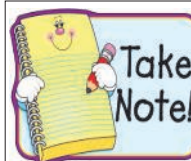
Totus Tuus
