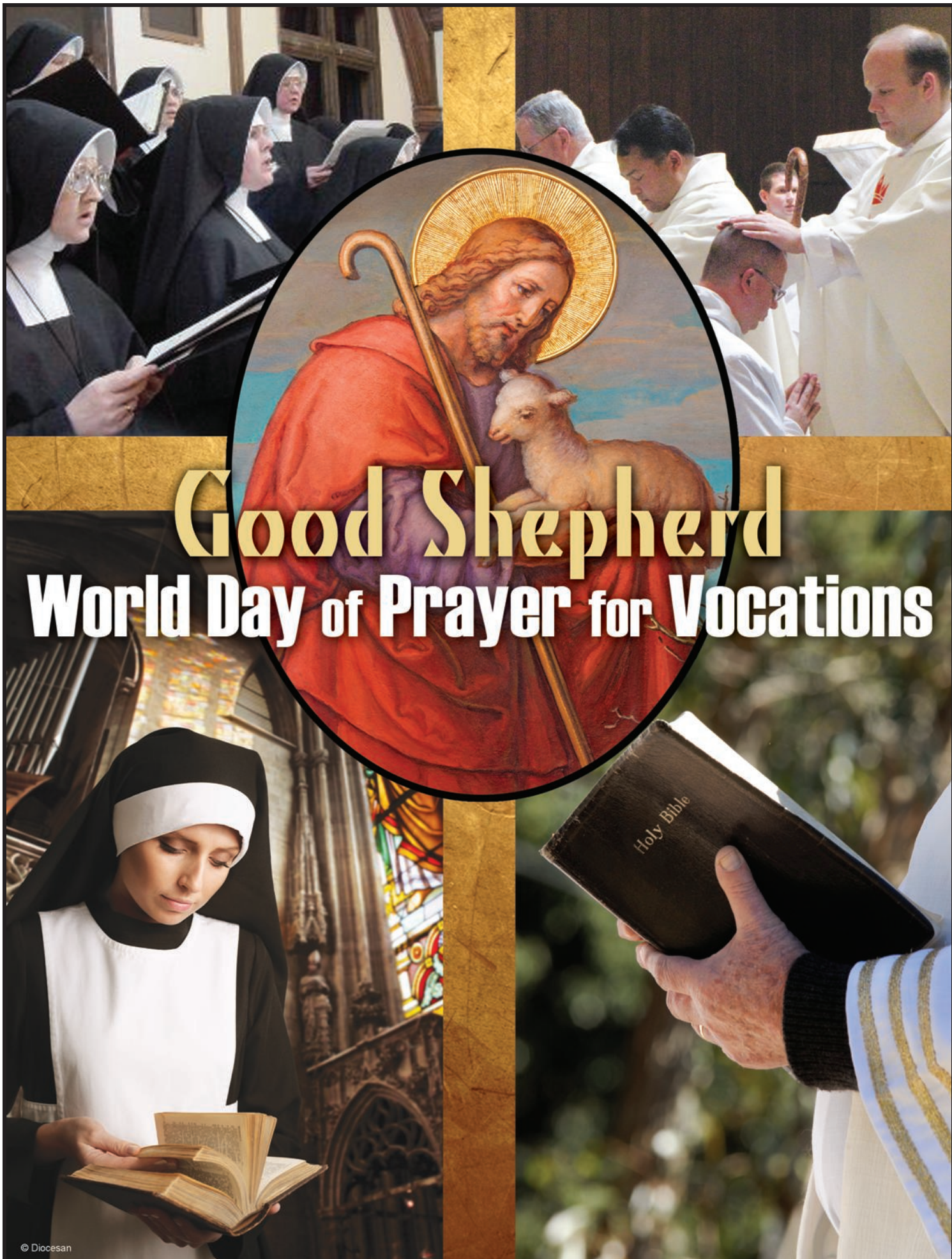

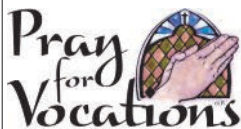
Totus Tuus
