There will be no Daily Mass from May 8th through May 11th. Father will be gone. Thank you for your understanding!



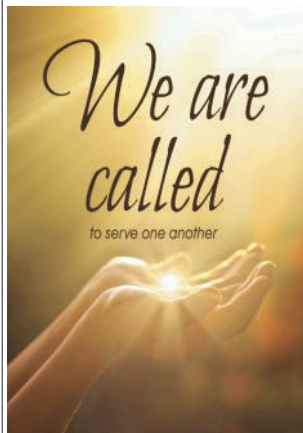
Liturgical Schedule
