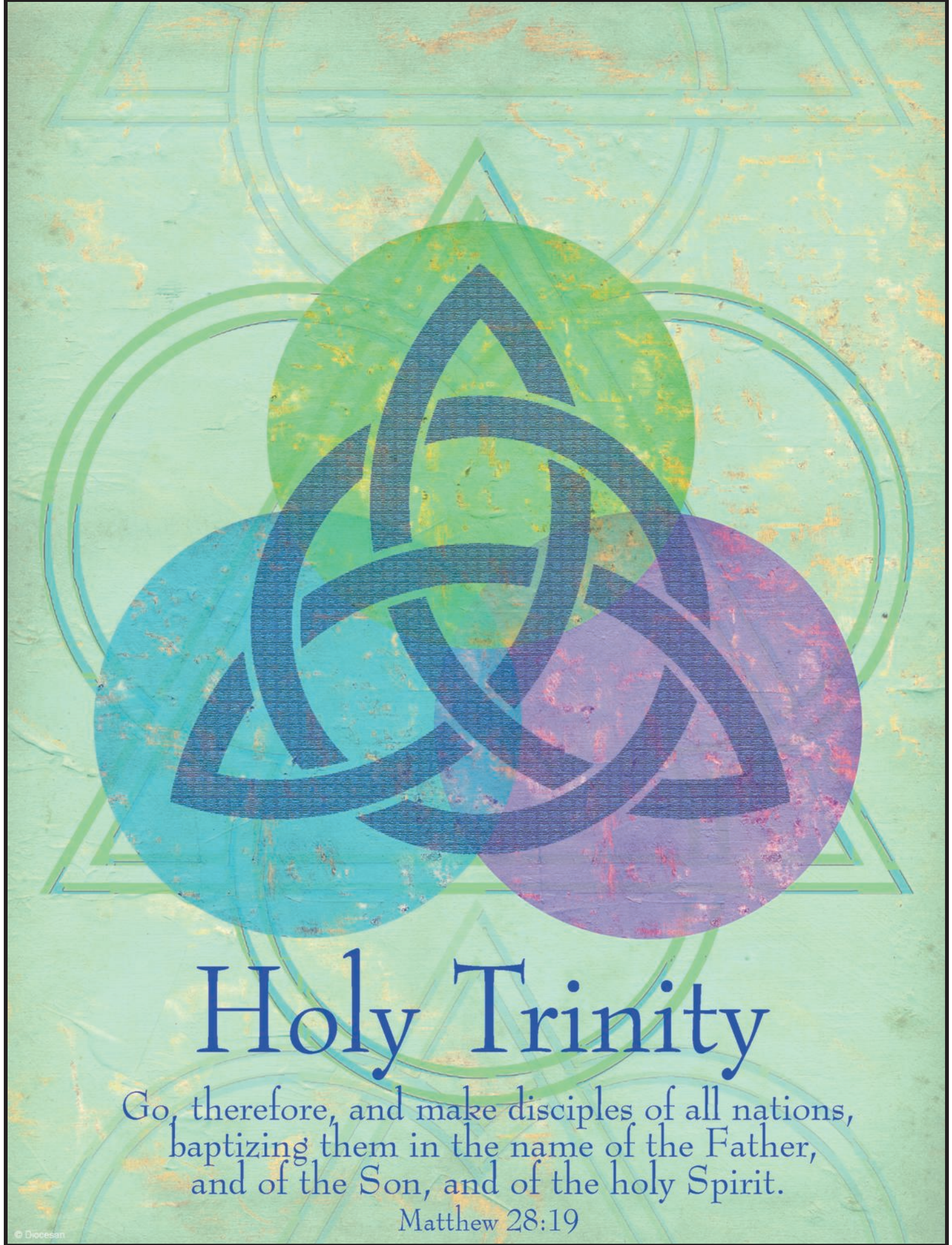

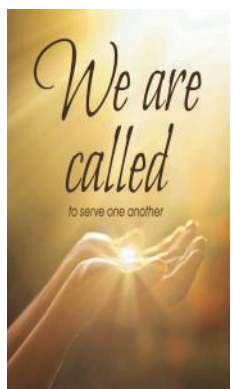
A Chance to be Amazed!
