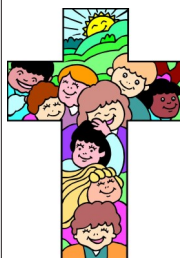

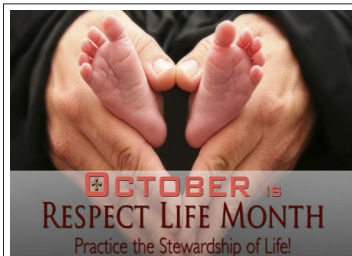

There will be no daily mass on October 17th, 19th, and 24th. Father will be gone. Thank you for your understanding.

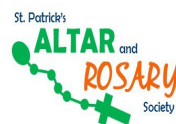


Roof News
