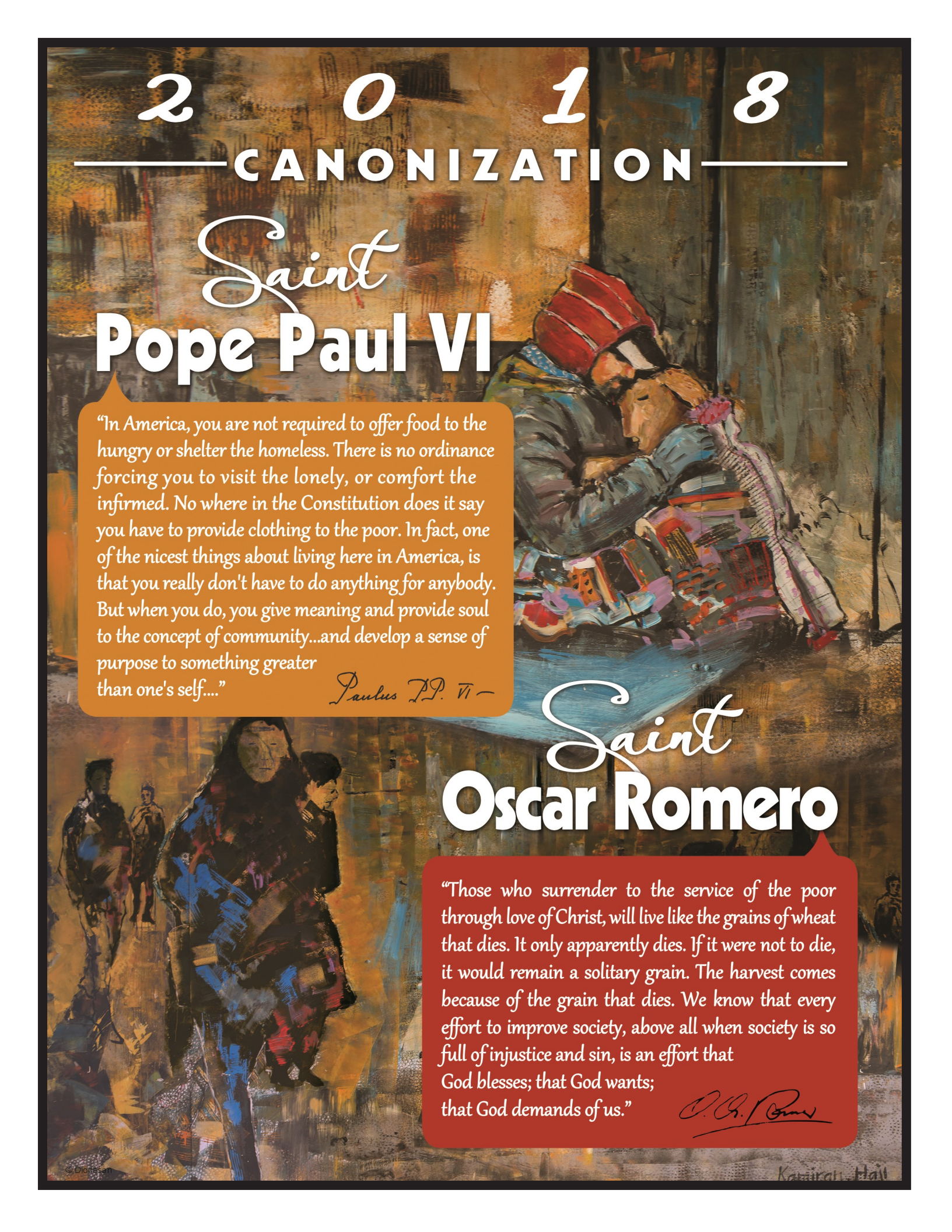

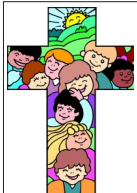

Arts & Crafts Bazaar

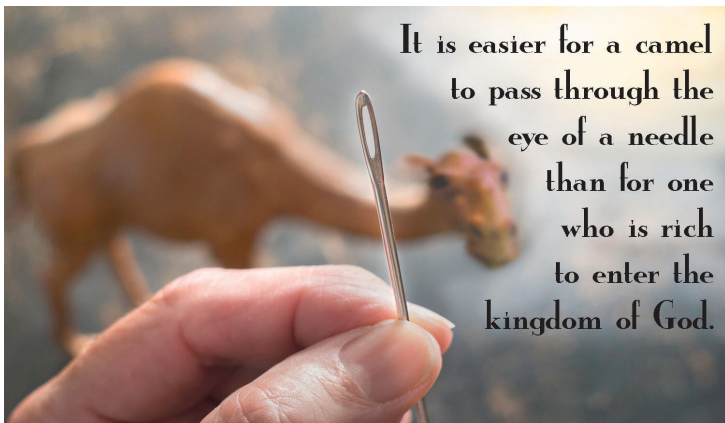

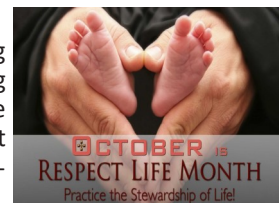
