**Spaghetti Dinner!**

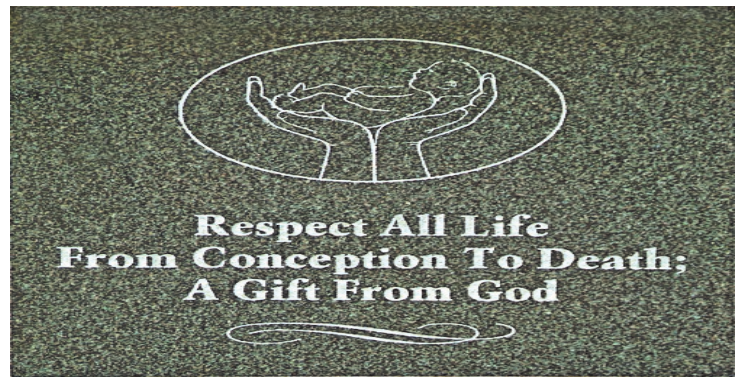
