Divine Mercy Prayer Group

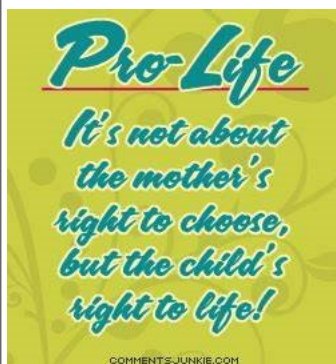

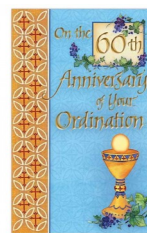


Preschool Teacher Needed
