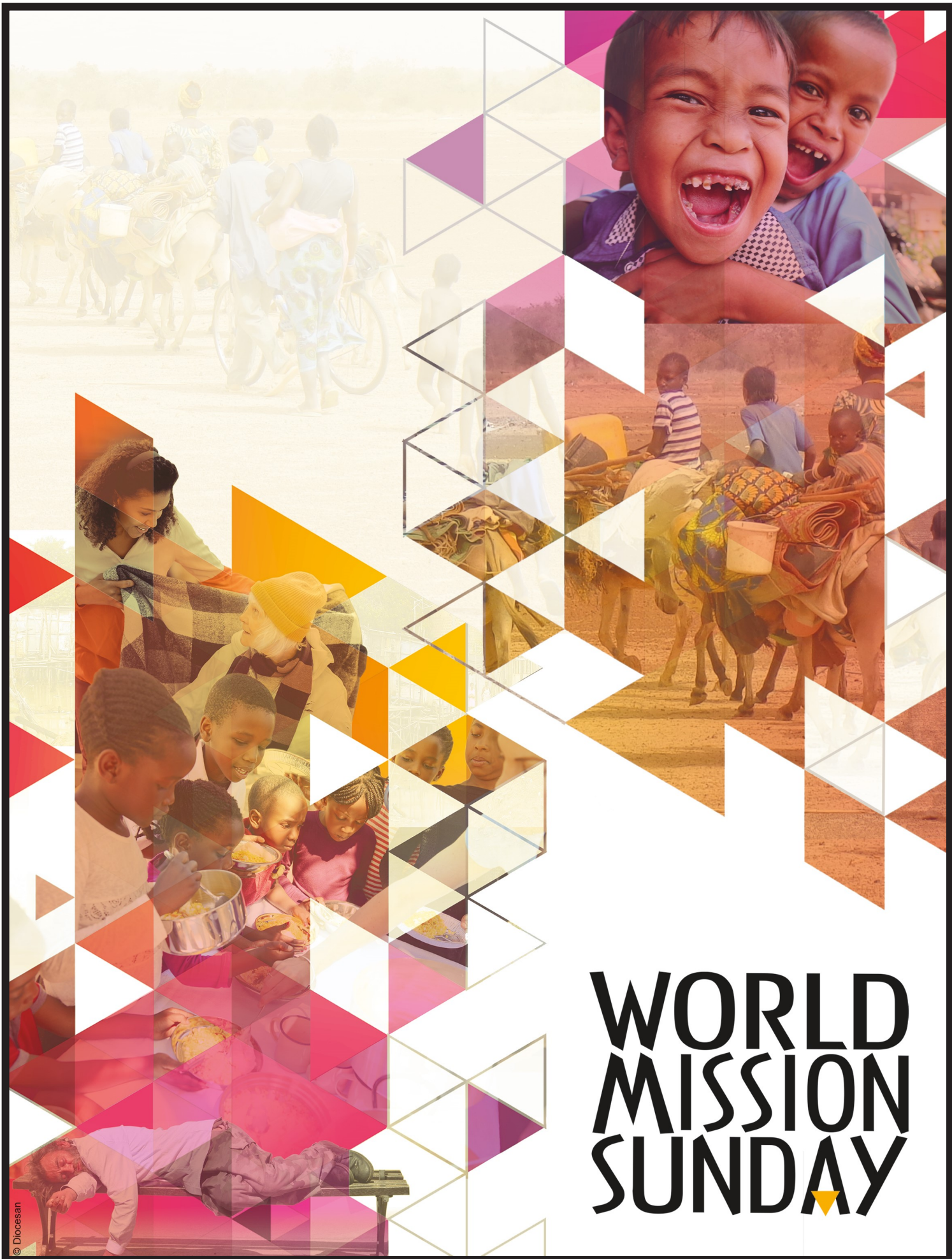

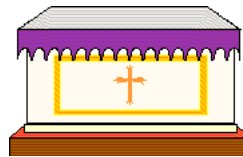
Pro-Life Events**Post-Abortion Healing Retreat**

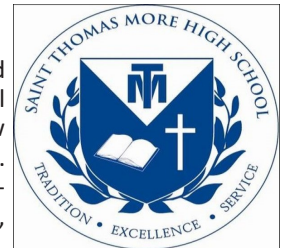

**Altar & Rosary News****A/R Prolife Baby Shower**

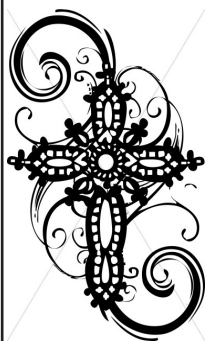
