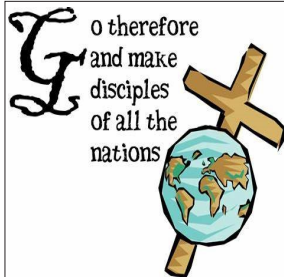

A/R Prolife Baby Shower**

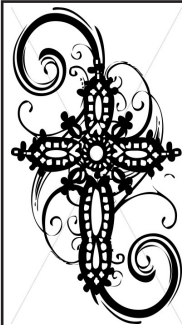
