Champaign/Urbana Venerable Fulton Sheen Guild

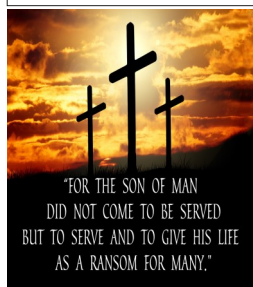
