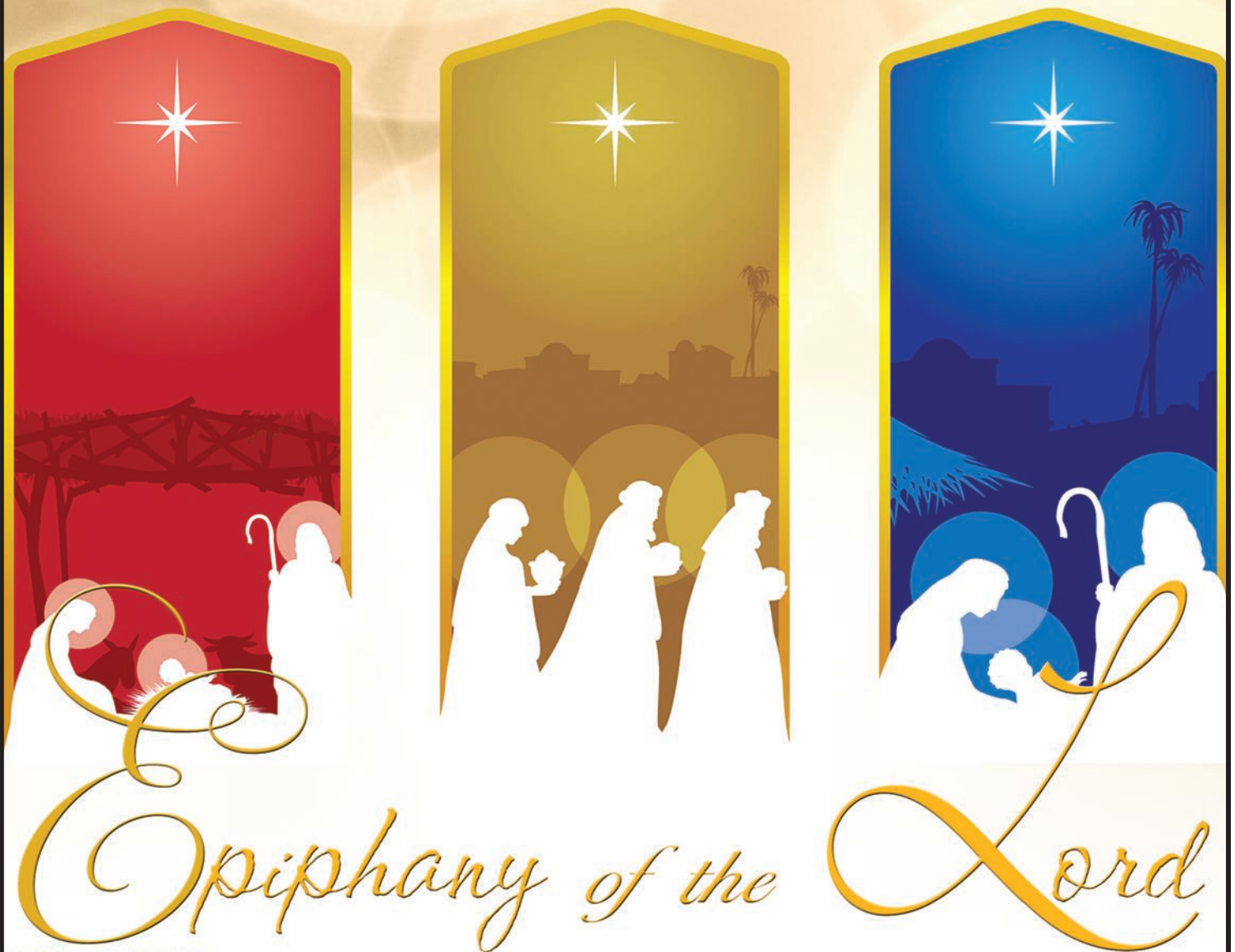

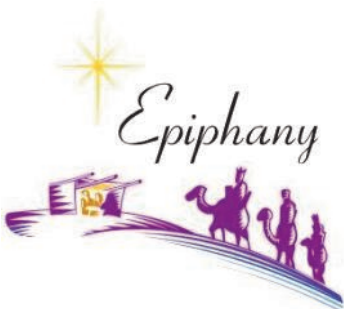
Time for Pecans!!!
