Hospital Rules

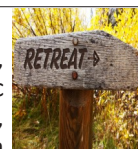

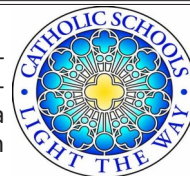
Attention Crafters:
