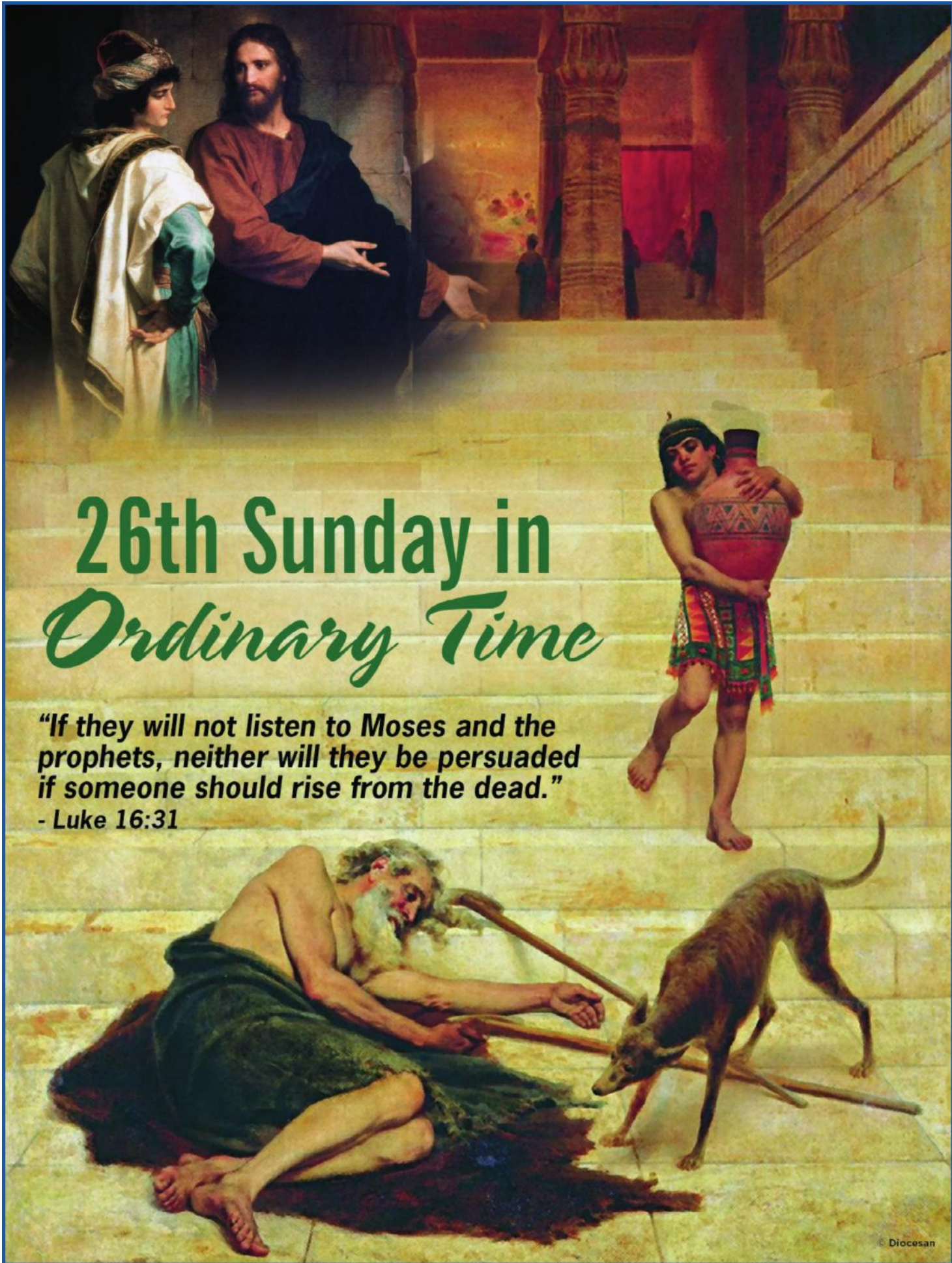

The Catholic Medical Association, is offering their Annual White Mass on October 15th at 9 am at St. Matthew's Catholic Church, Champaign.

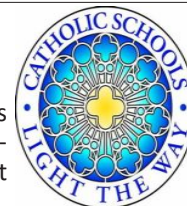
This mass is traditionally celebrated for, and in honor of, all those in the healthcare profession.

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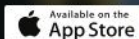

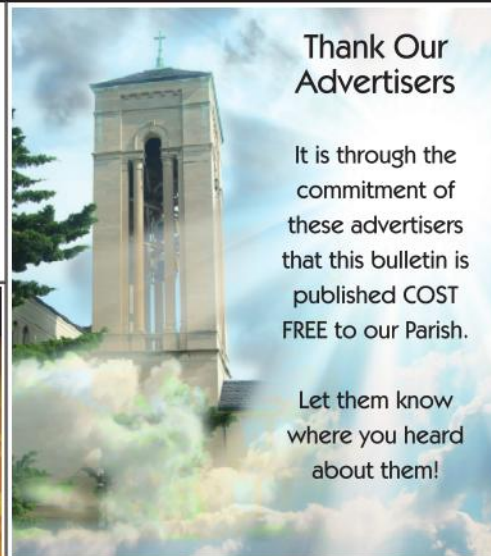
