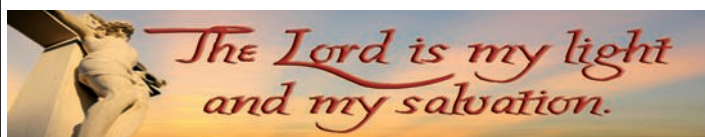

**Time for Pecans!!!**

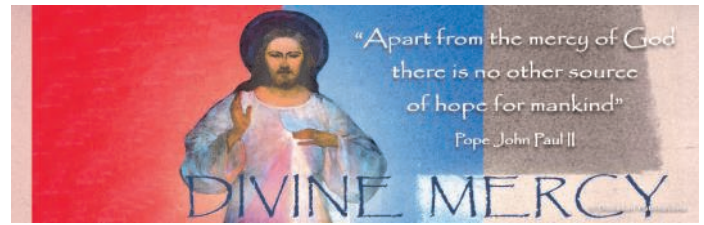
