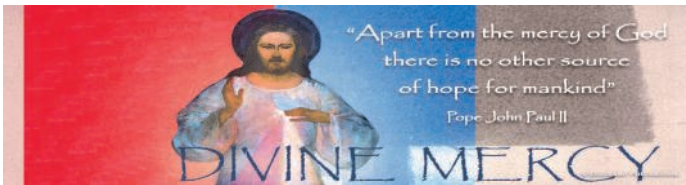
Liturgical Schedule

helping transform our church into a spring time of Easter joy!

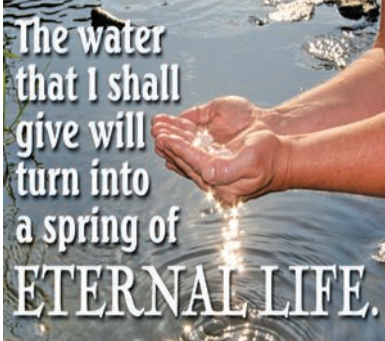
Hospital Visits

Lenten Regulations & Recommendations

- Everyone 14 years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent.
- Everyone who is at least 18 years of age and not yet 59 is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- On this day of fast, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken; but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals on these days is not permitted but liquids are allowed.
- Where health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Catholics are bound to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, especially during the Easter Season.

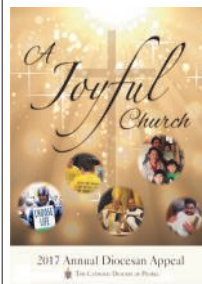


Fish Fry
