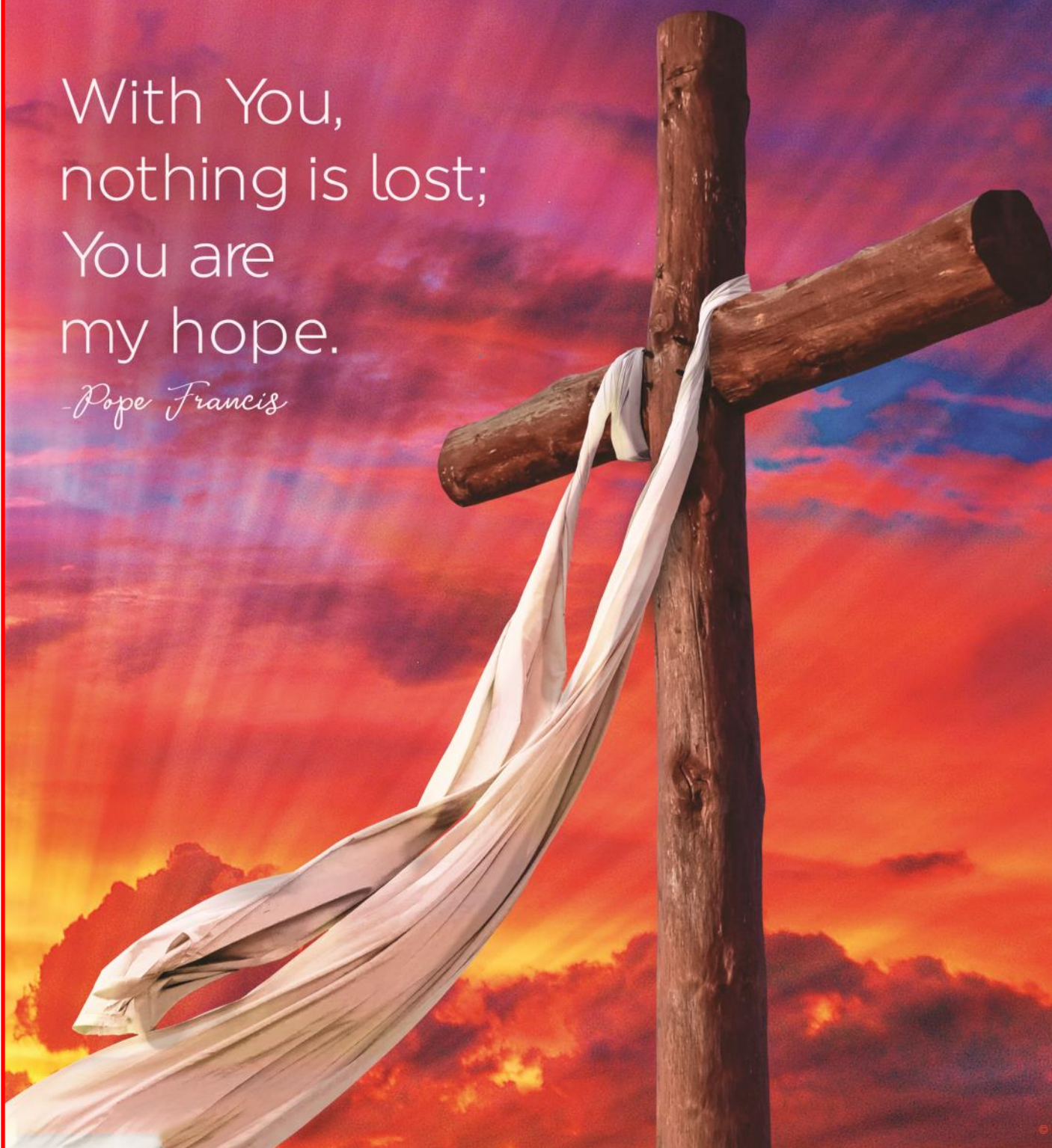

STM SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

A St. Thomas More scholarship established in Mr. Robert L. Aimone's honor supports students from St. Thomas, Philo; Immaculate Conception, Bongard; St. Mary, Pesotum; St. Boniface, Seymour; St. Joseph, Ivesdale; and St. Patrick, Tolono. All STM families from these parishes are eligible to apply. Each year STM will grant up to two scholarships of \$1,000 each to two STM students. Students must reapply each year for consideration.
