CARE OF GOD'S CREATION

3 --A Weekly Tip on Caring for Our Common Home
Try to buy fresh fruit and vegetables not packaged in plastic. Take your own reusable mesh bags. Mesh bags can be laundered and kept with your reusable grocery bags. This eliminates the need to use the grocer's plastic produce bags which are difficult to recycle.

4 --A Weekly Tip on Caring for Our Common Home
To reduce plastic use, try buying bars of soap/shampoo instead of plastic pump bottles. Purchase detergents in cardboard boxes, not plastic. There are also laundry strips available for purchase in stores and on-line to replace liquid or powders.
