May is Lupus awareness month. Lupus is an autoimmune condition causing inflammation and pain in the body, often causing symptoms in the skin, joints and internal organs. Lupus affects primarily women ages 15-44 and is more likely to affect people who are African American, Asian American, Hispanic/Latino, Native American, or Pacific Islander. People with a family member who has lupus or other autoimmune conditions are also more likely to have lupus. If you have symptoms bothering you (especially fatigue, joint pain or abnormal facial rash) or symptoms that do not make sense, please see your doctor for diagnostic screening.
