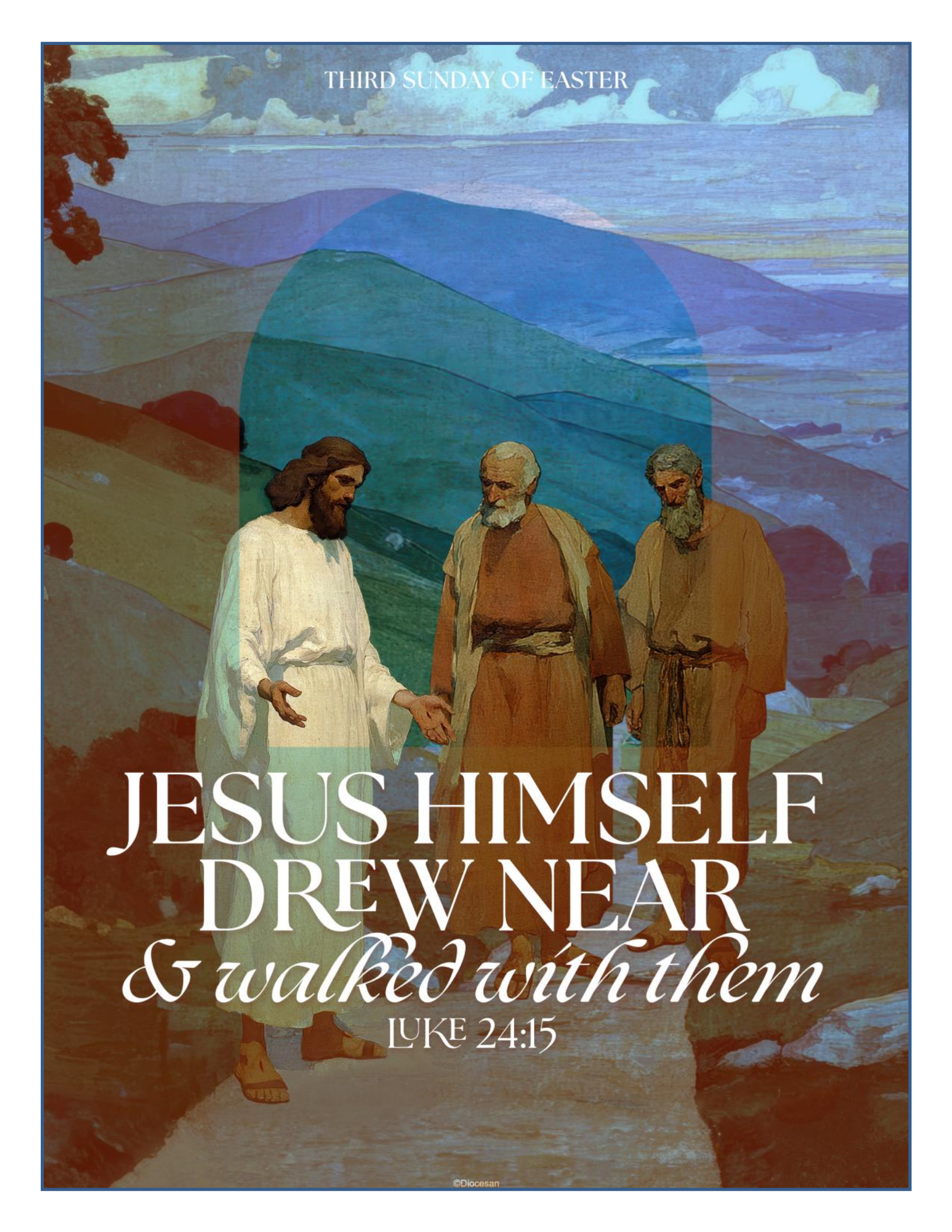

"An estimated 54,000 new cases of oral cancer will be diagnosed in the U.S. this year. Of those individuals, 43 percent will not survive longer than five years, and many who do survive suffer long-term problems, such as severe facial disfigurement or difficulties with eating and speaking. The death rate associated with oral and oropharyngeal cancers remains particularly high because the cancers routinely are discovered late in their development. Regular oral cancer examinations performed by your oral health professional remain the best method for detecting oral cancer in its early stages." – Oral Cancer Foundation
