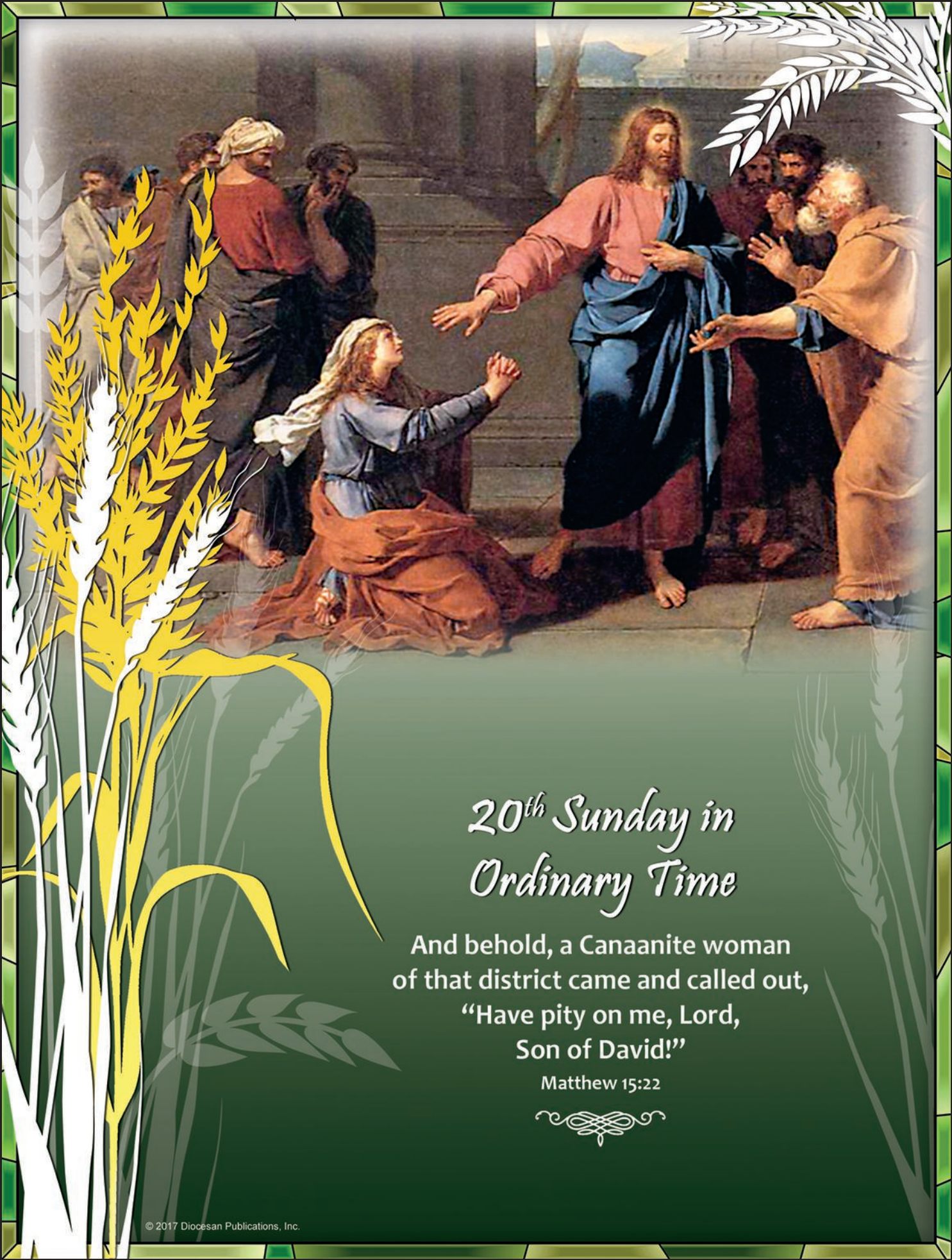

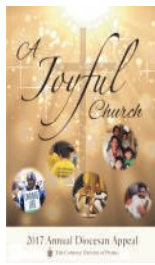
Little Flowers News
