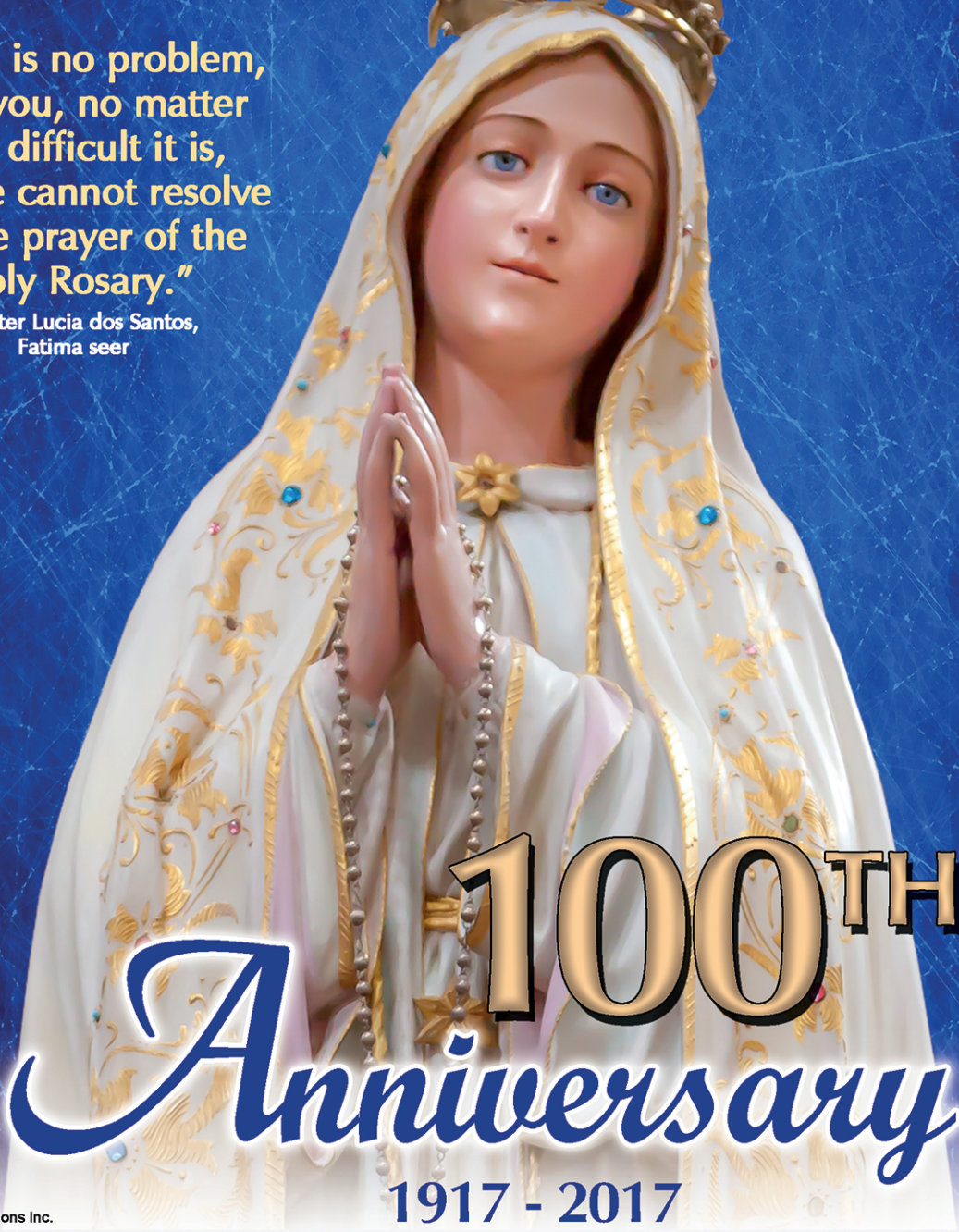

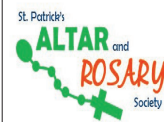


Server Sign Up
